The Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch Up Premium for 2019/20 is £ 9388

We intend to use this funding to provide:

Teaching Assistant support

Lexia reading programme

Specialist Teaching Assistant support in mathematics

Additional staffing to carry out intensive reading practice with targeted Year 7 pupils

Resources to support 'catch up' literacy programme which is a planned intervention for individual students

Outcomes

In September 2018, 23 students joined Year 7 with a Key Stage 2 reading score of below 100 and 21 with a Key Stage 2 scaled mathematics score of below 100.

The table below shows the progress made by students by the end of year 7.

Good Progress	52% (12 students)	10% (2 students)
Expected Progress	48% (11 students)	74% (11 students)
