The Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch-up Premium for 2018/19 is £ 9,000

We intend to use this funding to provide:

Teaching Assistant support

Lexia reading programme

Specialist Teaching Assistant support in mathematics

Additional staffing to carry out intensive reading practice with targeted Year 7 pupils

Resources to support planned interventions:” Catch-Up” and “GROW KS3” literacy programmes with individual pupils.

Outcomes

In September 2017 34 students joined Year 7 with a Key Stage 2 scaled Mathematics score of below 100 and 34 with a Key Stage 2 Reading score of below 100.

The table below shows the progress made by students by the end of year 7.

Year 7 2017-18	English (34 students)	Mathematics (34 students)
Good Progress	35% (12 students)	15% (5 students)
Expected Progress	65% (22 students)	85% (29 students)
